Automating Securities Regulation with DOCQNET

Public sector agencies responsible for regulating organizations licensed through FINRA rely upon several data sources to manage the licensing and examination of Broker Dealers and Investment Advisors. These sources include CRD/IARD reports, NASAA risk based exam scheduling spreadsheet, and a variety of other databases and spreadsheets used internally to manage workload and historical information.

Many agencies face challenges with managing workload, accurately creating and calculating risk-based examination plans, and management reporting of key metrics like approvals, renewal rates, application turnaround times, and workload tracking.

With DOCQNET all of these tasks are fully automated. Using data imported directly from CRD/IARD DOCQNET maintains a central repository of organizations and related licenses, which are accessible via any web browser. This includes current license status, historical exam status, and past/current complaints and enforcement actions. DOCQNET uses this information to generate annual Exam Plans that are fully compliant with FINRA data and NASAA risk calculation rules.

Overview


Department of Business Oversight, formerly known as Department of Corporations, is responsible for the licensing and enforcement regulations for nearly all major types of financial entities in the state of California. The Department must meet federal compliance guidelines, work with federal and state business partners, and serve the state's financial services organizations.  Automation import and processing of FINRA data – DOCQNET takes daily reports produced from CRD/IARD and imports them into a central database where applications, amendments, and renewals

can be reviewed and processed by the state regulator. DOCQNET supports custom business rules for agencies to define what types of applications to automatically approve, and what types to keep in a pending state for regulator approval.

 Automated deficiency checklist tracking and workload management – DOCQNET allows licensing specialists to conduct a deficiency review and tracks the results in a Deficiency Checklist. Once the deficiency review has been completed, the system automatically formats



and sends emails and correspondence with deficiencies noted by the regulator, and tracks the receipt of response by the licensee.

- Automated Exam Plan Creation DOCQNET creates an electronic Exam Plan for all firms that are in the state and are eligible for an examination in the fiscal year. The system includes checks for several business rules, such as whether a firm has been licensed for more than 6 months. It calculates a risk assessment using the published NASAA risk assessment formulas to create four pools of Exam Plans for organizations and branches.
 - Investment Advisor Firms eligible for examination
 - Broker/Dealer Firms eligible for examination
 - Branch offices eligible for examination
 - Firms eligible for indoctrination

The system will automatically select 40% of the Risk 1 category, 35% of the Risk 2 category and 25% of the Risk 3 category, organizations and branches and add them to their respective Exam Plans.

Assign and Administer Licensing and Examinations

DOCQNET includes a workflow engine that allows supervisors to create individual examinations, assign them to an

Examiner, and track the due date of the exam. Pre-Examination Findings includes recording of tracking of all major




